## **APPLICATION FOR 2022 TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP**

**Deadline:** Please submit this application to Elizabeth Root, Scholarship Coordinator at the Mammoth Lakes Foundation ([elizabeth@mammothlakesfoundation.org](mailto:elizabeth@mammothlakesfoundation.org)) no later than **5:00 p.m. Friday, April 8, 2022.**

**Eligibility:** Students who have spent at least 2 semesters as Dave's Scholars in good standing with the Mammoth Lakes Foundation and Cerro Coso Community College – Mammoth campus graduating with an Associate's degree in May 2022, or who graduated in December 2021 may apply. Recipients of the Rotary scholarship are not eligible to receive both scholarships.

Student GPA (3.25 minimum preferred), coursework, and LRC and MLF check-ins will weigh heavily in the selection process. Selected applicants will participate in a personal interview with a committee comprised of MLF and Cerro Coso staff, board members, and donors. Final award is contingent upon cumulative GPA and successful completion of the Associate's degree.

**Award:** The scholarship recipient will be announced at Cerro Coso Commencement, currently scheduled for Friday, May 13, 2022 (subject to change). The scholarship funds tuition for one student, up to \$10,000 per year for two years at any California State University (CSU) campus, the University of Nevada Reno (UNR), a University of California (UC) campus or another public or private, accredited college or university. Maximum award of \$20,000. The student is expected to complete their Bachelor's degree within the two-year timeframe. The recipient will be required to sign and abide by a contract outlining all terms of the scholarship.
